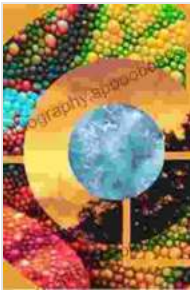


14th European Conference Ecsa 2024 Aquila Italy September 14-18, 2024

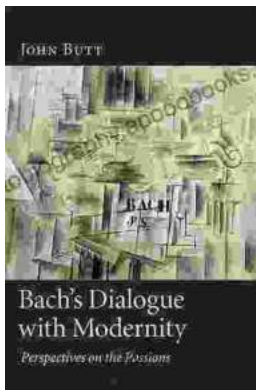

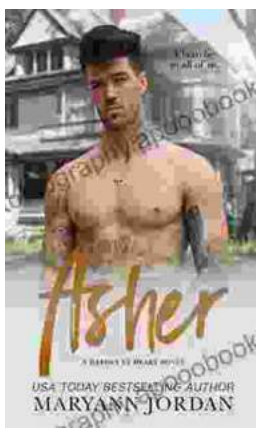
