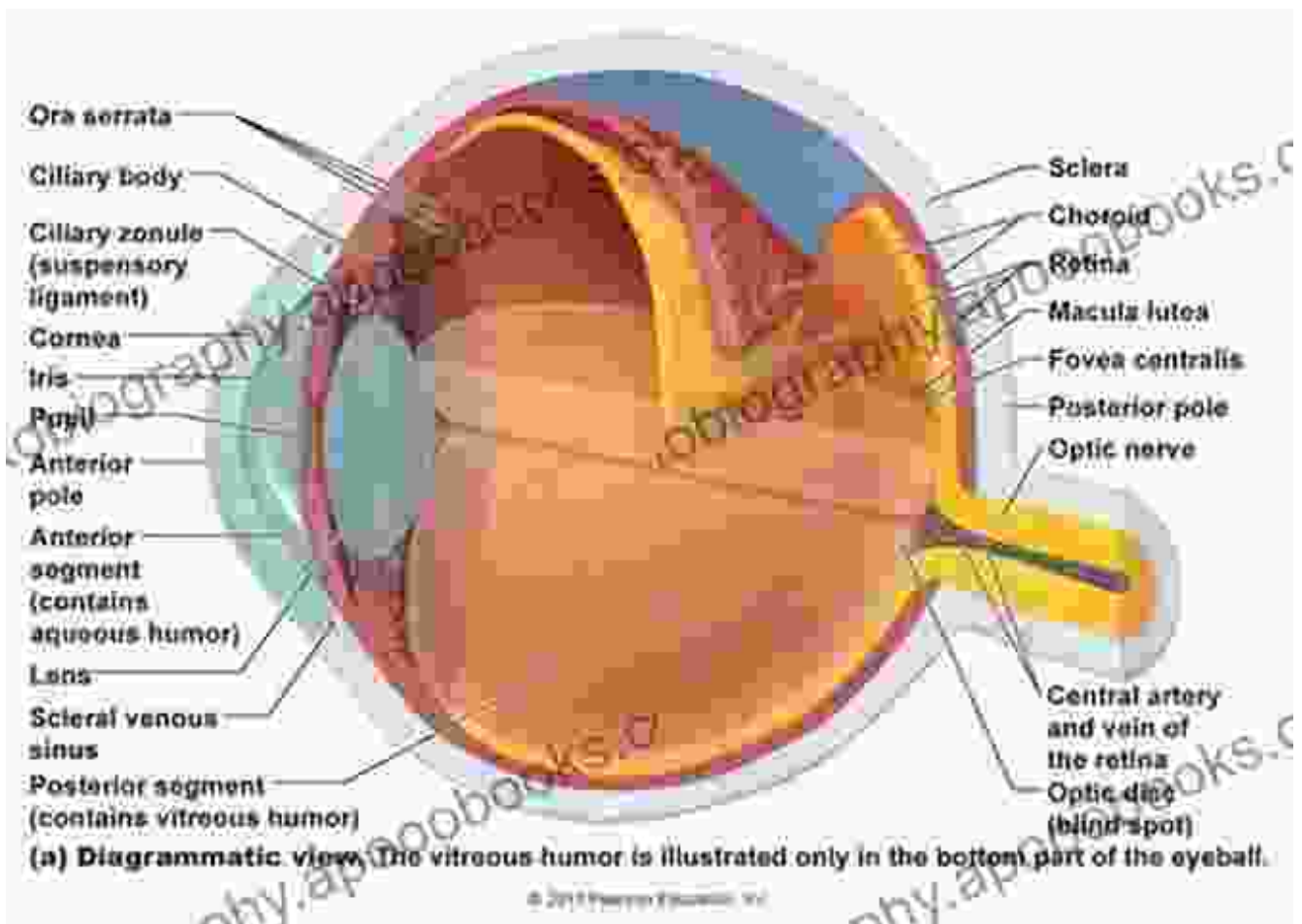

(a) Xanthelasma yellowish plaques on the lower eyelid
(b) Arcus senilis a grey ring between cornea and limbus
- 7-**porphyria cutanea tarda**:
Increased hairiness at the outer canthus
- 8-**Anemia**: Pale conjunctiva
- 9-**Gaucher's disease**: Yellowish deposits on corneal sides
- 10-**Vitamin A deficiency**: Bitot's spots (hyperkeratosis)
- 11-**Infective endocarditis**: Petechiae on the fornix
- 12-**MC meningitis**: Petechiae on the bulbar conjunctiva
- 13-**Hypercalcaemia**
Grey discoloration spreading radially to the limbus
- 14-**Wilson's disease**: brown band around the limbus
- 15-**TB-Tonsillitis/Plasmoma**: Painless conjunctival nodule
- 16-**Graves Disease**: exophthalmos-Upper lid retraction

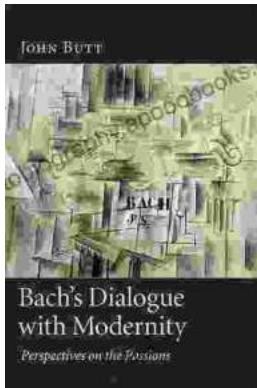

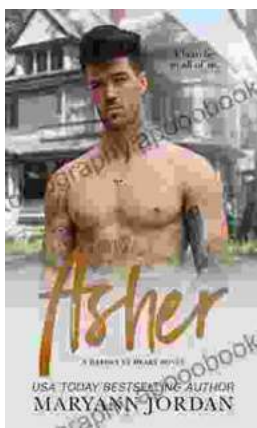
