


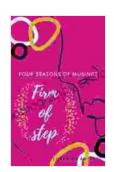
Sherwin Bitsui is a Navajo writer who was born and raised on the Navajo reservation in New Mexico. Bitsui is a graduate of the Institute of American
