
The Day Democracy Died: A Warning for Our Times

Applebaum then turns her attention to the more recent collapse of democracy in Hungary under Viktor Orbán. Orbán, a former liberal who has


since embraced authoritarianism, has systematically dismantled democratic institutions in Hungary and consolidated his own power.




