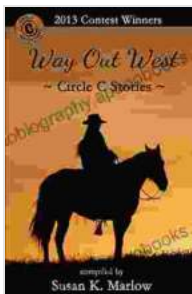


Way Out West Circle Stories: A Literary Journey Through the American West

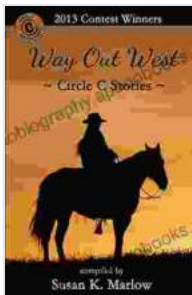

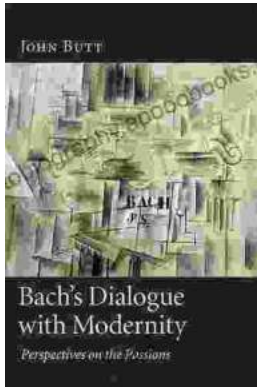
